



YEAR 11 CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER TERM 2, 2020/21

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope everyone had enjoyable New Year and Christmas holidays. We shall continue to observe covid prevention measures more strictly this term due to the rising of occurrence of covid cases. The wearing of masks shall therefore be enforced at all times. This being an examination year, students should expect a higher amount of work particularly homework.

Year 11

English: Students will be revising different styles of writing including writing to inform, describe, persuade, argue and explain. We will also be looking at comprehension and summarizing skills. Students will also be preparing material for their oral certificates.

English literature: Students will be completing their study of the crucible before revising drama and novel texts they studied previously.

Mathematics: We will be looking at differentiation, functions and calculating area and volume of different types of cuboids and trigonometry.

Biology: Students will be looking at inheritance, variation and environment, biotechnology and revision for IGCSE.

Economics: We will be looking at government and the macro economy moving on to economic development

Chemistry: In chemistry this term we will be looking at electricity and chemistry, stoichiometry and metals.

Physics: We will be looking at sound waves, electricity and magnetism

French: We will continue looking at communication and language covering pronouns, conditionals, expression of time and conjunctives.

Geography: Students will be studying coasts and rivers thereafter moving on to geographic skills, development, food production and settlements

ICT: Students will be looking at document production, web authoring and analysis and presentation.

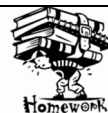
Business studies: Students will be studying external influences on business activities and begin revising for their IGSCSE exams.

Life Skills: Students will learn about becoming active citizens. They will also be encouraged to begin thinking about their future career.
