Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope everyone had enjoyable Easter holidays. We shall continue to observe covid 19 prevention measures strictly and the wearing of masks shall be enforced. This being an IGCSE examination term, students should expect an above-normal revision workload.

Year 11

English: Students will be revising different components of the language in preparation for exams to be taken on 5th and 7th May.

English literature: Students will be doing revision in preparation for exams which will be written on 20th May.

Mathematics: we will be revising statistics, probability and vectors and many more topics. Students will sit their IGCSE examinations on 4th and 6th May

Biology: Students will be revising in preparation for examinations which will be written on May 12th and June 11th.

Chemistry: In chemistry students will be revising in preparations for exams on May 6th and 8th June

Physics: We will be doing an across-the-spectrum revision as students prepare to sit their IGCSE physics exams on the 19th of May and on June 9th.

French: We will be revising to prepare for exams which will be taken on 10th and 17th of May

Geography: students will be studying costs and rivers thereafter moving on to geographic skills, development, food production and settlements. 5th and 18th May.

ICT: Students will be doing revision and writing IGCSE exams on 20th April and on 10th May.

Business studies: Students will be revising for their IGSCCE exams which will be taken on May 21st and 26th

Economics: Students shall be revising in preparation for exams which will be taken on 28th May and 10th June.

Art and Design: Students will be looking at beauty.

Life Skills: Students will complete letters of applications, CVs and carry out mock interviews.

Students will receive approximately one hour's homework per subject each week. They should therefore expect to be carrying out around two hours of study each night. Reading is still considered to be very important and we therefore expect children to continue to read independently at home.
